

Communication: Developmental Milestones

Communication milestones are a specific developmental stage in a child's ability to understand and produce language.

Birth- 3 Months:

- Looks at your face
- · Reacts to loud sounds
- · Makes sounds other than crying





3-4 Months:

- · Smiles to get caregiver's attention
- Looks, moves, or makes sounds to get or keep caregiver's attention
- · Turns head towards the sound of caregiver's voice

Milestones are significant markers in individual development, they allow us to monitor growth and identify potential areas of concern for intervention.

5-6 Months:

- · Takes turns making sounds with caregiver
- Makes different sounds like "mamama" and "bababa"

7-9 Months:

- Shows several facial expressions like happy, sad, angry, and surprised
- Smiles or laughs when you play peek-a-boo
- Lifts arms to be picked up



Interactive games like peek-a-boo or simple roleplaying, help children practice turn-taking and understand conversation skills.



10-12 Months:

- Waves bye-bye
- Points to ask for something or to get help





16-18 Months:

- Points to show something of interest
- Follows direction of gaze, head turn, and/or pointing gesture of another person

31-36 Months:

- Talks with you in conversation using at least two back-and-forth exchanges
- Follows two-step directions
- Asks "who", "what", "where", or "why" questions





Excessive screen time, especially passive watching without interaction, can negatively affect communication development.



36-60 Months:

- Says sentences with 4 or more words
- Follows 3 step directions
- Asks for meaning of words

Have concerns about a child meeting these milestones?

- Your primary care physician an refer you to an early intervention or early childhood program
