Early Intervention Clearinghouse (EIC) Overview

- There are Tip Sheets available on their website (eicclearinghouse.org) with information on Early Intervention topics and guidance on child development.
- EIC Resource Guides are collections of materials like books, videos, websites, organizations, and articles focused on specific topics.
- Librarians are available to help gather materials on specific topics, even difficult-to-research subjects.
- Spanish-speaking staff are ready to assist Spanish-speaking families if they wish to receive support.
- EI Clearinghouse has a Lending Library which is available to all Illinois residents, not just families enrolled in Early Intervention (EI).
- Families in EI can apply for EIC's Technology Loan Program to join live video visits or Telehealth appointments.

Lending Library Quick Facts

- There are no late fees or replacement fees.
- Instructions will come with the borrowed items on how to return them. There is also an option to return books from EIC to your local library.
- A variety of topics, languages, and materials are available.
 - Topics in the Lending Library:
 - Parenting
 - Early childhood development
 - Picture and board books
 - Young children with special needs
- Books are available in English, Arabic, Chinese, French, Polish, Urdu, Spanish and Russian.
- To access e-books, families must request a username and password.
- Types of materials available:

 - DVDs
 - Kits (book & activity set)

Technology Loan Program

- iPad/Hotspot is available to borrow for families enrolled in EI.
- The loan term for technology is from the moment the item is received until the family is no longer in EI.
